

To log into Google classroom you will only need to use the above information in bold.




Open Internet Explorer or Google Chrome and type in the search engine 'RM Unify'. Please click on the top link to sign in.






Once you have clicked on the sign in link, it will take you to the sign in page.






Please type in the email address and password provided on your child's label.





When you log in this should appear. If Google Classroom does not appear click on the 'add' button.






Then search for Google Classroom.




Click on I'm a student.

Accessing Work




To access the work set from the class teacher please click on 'classwork' and then 'class drive folder.'
